

## **HARB MEETING - March 4, 2009**

**Meeting opened at 7:00 PM. Present were Peter Zimmerman, Estelle Cremers, Linda Walters, Karl Snyder, Jill Snively, Chuck Cutlip and Peggy Galloway.**

**Minutes from the February 11, 2009 HARB meeting were read and approved as read.**

**Plans for the Train Station were given approval with the following changes and exception: elimination of stove pipe; and the recommendation that the bottom section of wall under windows be painted a dark color. The exception was the light fixture it was not approved. Peter will recommend a light fixture for future approval.**

**Conditions of the Cigar Building was again a topic of concern. We had made a request for materials to be put aside so that future replacements could be made with accuracy. We again asked Jay Kellog about this and requested that he turn these materials over to the Historic Commission. Jay Kellog thought they were too numerous and cumbersome to have us keep them. Linda Walters on behalf of the HARB made a personal request to Jay Kellog for these materials. Also, Earth Enterprise was again reminded to do what was necessary to preserve the foundation of this building. Karl Snyder will make a visit to the site.**

**A request for a demolition permit was made by Peter Smyrl for the removal of porches on the Jacob house on Piersol Road. The request was granted.**

**Barry Bentley's property on James Mill Rd. is having repairs on an agriculture building. Although the work being done did not need a building permit it was noted that Mr. Bentley should have, and should in the future, come to the Historical Commission first. We thanked Mr. Bentley for his time and the materials he brought for our review.**

**Jim Barker brought up the subject of the Seventh Day Baptist Cemetery on Rt. 23 - east of Knauertown. We informed him that we were aware of the problems that existed and hoped to have something positive done in the future to repair the wall.**
