The final draft of the Design Guidelines is expected before the close of December. Members will have a chance to review and make final comments to Frens & Frens before the document is finalized and submitted to the BOS for approval.

French Creek Golf Club has requested permission to erect a cell tower on their property which has several township residents concerned. Since the golf course isn't located in Warwick Township we have no input.

A developer is in negotiations with Morgantown Borough to build a casino adjacent to the Turnpike exit. How this will affect the historic integrity of Warwick Township must be discussed further once details are known. The same developer is also negotiating the acquisition of the airport property, just to the west of Elverson, and proposes multi-unit townhomes.

Jean Sauer will have the final Warwick Village house list for the 2019 Town Tours & Village Walks (scheduled for June 27, 2019) at our December meeting.

St. Mary's Chapel in Warwick Village announced it has combined parishes and will now be known as The Church of St. Mary's at Calvary.

There being no further business, Dave motioned to adjourn the meeting. Elaine seconded, and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:28pm.
