The meeting was called to order at 6pm by Karl Snyder.

1. 1944 Harmonyville Rd., Pottstown, PA – Dale Lutz. Class 3 property

Mr. Lutz made application to rebuild the chimney on his circa 1940-1950 home. The chimney will be brick, 1 foot higher than the existing and have a stainless-steel chimney cap. Elaine made motion to approve, Karl seconded, and the motion carried.

2. 120 Hopewell Rd., Elverson, PA – Linda Palmer. Class 2 property

Mrs. Palmer requested approval to temporarily replace a section of the main roof of the house with corrugated metal (bronze color). Noting extenuating circumstances, Elaine made motion to approve, Jean seconded, and the motion carried.

Other Business:

As part of the Design Guidelines Task Force, Jean gave an overview of the township tour with Frens & Frens, Karl and herself on 5/11/18. The purposes of the tour was to show the various types of housing and historic areas of the township.

Linda suggested the Historical Commission sponsor a lecture series to educate residents on local history. Several topics were discussed most of which focused on George Washington's connection to the township during the Revolutionary War and the early iron industry. More discussion is needed.

Elaine and Linda are putting together a list of interviewees and questions for the Oral History Project. This project is ongoing as well.
