Meeting Minutes  
15 July 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7pm by Karl Snyder.

Minutes from the June 17, 2019 Historic Commission Meeting were read by Joan Drennen and approved by the board.

The final count of 220 guests at the Warwick Village Walk was discussed. Linda Walters reported that Karen Marshall of The Chester County Town Tours and Village Walks stated that the walk was “a great success.”

Linda Walters recommended that Karl Snyder and David Lignore begin the process of recording the oral histories of Charles Jacob, Frank Guest, and Richard Fisher. They agreed that they would do this.

The meeting was continued at 860 Warwick Furnace Road to review the HARB application for the proposed restoration and renovation of the existing Yellow House Bank Barn. Jason Swinehart and Paul Schmelzer joined the Historic Commission on site. The exterior and interior of the bank barn were inspected by Karl Snyder and Dave Lignore. Karl Snyder told Mr. Swinehart and Mr. Schmelzer that the drawings for their HARB application need to include specifications for the placement and size of all doors and windows.
