

Warwick Township Historical Commission Meeting

20 November 2017

Karl Snyder called the meeting to order at 9:20 p.m., following the HARB meeting, which began at 7 p.m.

Mr. Edward Rosen was there to discuss changes to the largest barn on his property, Warwick Furnace Farms. He questioned whether he needed to submit an Impact statement since the only removal he wants approval for is of a 1950's Marietta silo, the middle of 3 silos at the barn.

It was suggested to Mr. Rosen that he make separate applications for each project he is contemplating.

Mary Wickerham, of Warwick Village, was there to discuss the collapsing forebay of the barn on the Galloway property. She said many residents have contacted her regarding the barn, which they view as an eyesore. Peggy Galloway said she was aware of her neighbors' concerns and hoped that the repair or removal could begin soon. The cost is an issue for her.

Karen Flagg, a township resident, asked if the township had funds to help homeowners with needed repairs.

There being no further business, Elaine Adams called for adjournment at 9:45 p.m. Karl Snyder seconded the motion.
