New Business:



Most of the discussions were about our St. Peters Village Town Walk in 2012. Once we have a definite date, we will ask the township to post a request on the website for volunteers to help. Anticipating 300 visitors, we will need to provide a bottle of water for each visitor, plus refreshments at the end of the tour.

We discussed costumes. Linda has learned from a costume rental place, that \$95 is the average cost of renting a costume, plus a \$100 deposit for each costume. We decided not to rent costumes, but to encourage presenters who own Victorian clothes, to wear them. We would also like to have tee shirts for all volunteers, with a St. Peters logo. Karl said that our goals are to develop a short history of the village as handouts for volunteers and visitors and to recruit volunteers.

New Business:

Karl has been in discussions with Karen Marshall of the Chester County Historic Commission. Karen would like us to work on an atlas of Warwick Township. We hope to do this by 2013.

October 17, 2011 Minutes


Karl called the meeting to order 7:30 pm. at the Township Municipal Building. Present Karl Snyder and Peggy Galloway.
