



**Warwick Township Historical Commission
Minutes
January 2, 2024**

Call to Order: David Lignore called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM.

Approval of Minutes: Karl Snyder made a motion to approve the Minutes of December 18, 2023 as corrected. In the paragraph titled Iron Bridge/Cupola Furnace District, first line, HiC should be changed to HC. David Lignore seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Public Comment: There were no public comments this evening.

Iron Bridge/Cupola Furnace District: Discussion continued from last month regarding the possible application for registration of the Iron Bridge/Cupola Furnace District on the National Register of Historic Places. In December, Elaine Adams had contacted Elisa Cremers, daughter of Mrs. Estelle Cremers, who had submitted paperwork regarding this application back in the 1990's, and requested that she search for any files regarding this paperwork submitted earlier. As Elaine Adams was not in attendance, no further information was provided at this time. It was decided that Warwick Township HC would like to support the application, and we will work together with Maureen Noonan of East Nantmeal to accomplish the application.

Town Tours and Village Walks: Discussion was held regarding the application for the 30th Annual Chester County Town Tours & Village Walks Summer 2024 which was sent to the HC Commission. It was decided that we would not participate this year, but the suggestion was made to possibly work on a Warwick Furnace Farm Tour in 2025 to



showcase the cannons recently found there and the projected building to hold one of the cannons. Research would need to be done to insure that there would be adequate parking, and that the Warwick Furnace Farm owners would agree to this possibility for a Town Tour.
