Call to Order: David Lignore called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

Approval of Minutes: Karl Snyder made a motion to accept the Minutes of January 20, 2025 as written. David Lignore seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Public Comment: There were no Public Comments this evening.

PA SHPO Guidance Letter: After reviewing the letter, discussion followed. The Historical Commission has a number of questions and will work with the township to get the answers. We will further review the necessary process for this possible application, and discuss it next month.

Quorum Guidelines: All read the Quorum Guidelines provided. Until the unfilled position is filled, we would need a quorum of three to meet the guidelines and be able to legally transact business.

The purpose for her visit would be to discuss the expectations for this person, as well as to discuss the ideas for the 250th anniversary event to be held next year. All HC members stated they would be willing to help with this event, but we had questions regarding the actual event possibilities, whether or not it is coordinated with Chester County Parks and



Recreation or some other organization, timing, date or dates, and other questions.
