



**Warwick Township Historical Commission
Minutes
June 15, 2026**

Members Present: Karl Snyder, Janet Gebhardt, Matt Tongiani, Craig Williams

Call to Order: Karl Snyder called the meeting to order at 7:02PM.

Approval of Minutes: Craig Williams made a motion to approve the Minutes of May 18, 2026 as written. Karl Snyder seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Public Comment: Benjamin Lewis, 416 County Park Road, Pottstown, PA, appeared before the HC to request approval to repair the siding and stucco on his house and repair rot that was present before new roof. He will replace it with German Bead Board in the exterior color of Sherwin Williams Dromedary Camel and Pure White trim. Karl Snyder made a motion to approve his request as presented. Matt Tongiani seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

- Stone Wall is providing 5 golf carts for the day
- There will be hay bales distributed around the area for seating
- French & Pickering Creek will be sure to mow trails the week before the event so it will be easier to get around
- Bright t-shirts will be provided for Staff so that they can be easily spotted if anyone needs assistance
